We recommend pre-anesthetic bloodwork to be performed prior to

surgery. *This helps us determine if there are any medical conditions which would cause us to adjust or hold-off on the spay*

Cost: \$160 if 7 years old or less, \$250 if greater than 7 years old.

We recommend placing an IV catheter for the procedure. *This allows us to better maintain blood pressure and is useful if we need to give any IV medicines during an emergency. In animals older than 7, this certainly becomes a greater concern.*

Cost of IV catheter, fluids, and monitoring: \$85

We recommend that all pets be microchipped. *If your pet is ever lost, this increases the chance that you will be reunited.*

Cost of implanting and registering a microchip for you: \$85

We recommend that your pet be kept in an E-collar for 2 weeks.

Many pets try to lick or chew at their incision, which can cause it to open or get infected.

Cost of E-collar: \$30, any size

Feline: \$350 Canine: \$450
